


Figure 1. Proportion of Career Planning for College Students

To improve the professional level of Higher Vocational teachers, schools can regularly carry out professional assessment to strengthen the ideological and political level of teachers and their own professional development. In the process of training, short-term training methods for teachers, long-term training programs and the combination of the two training programs will play a positive role in improving the education level of Higher Vocational teachers.
